Cultural Resources Inventory and Evaluation

This report identifies the locations of cultural resources, which are confidential. As nonrenewable resources, archaeological sites can be significantly impacted by disturbances that can affect their cultural, scientific, and artistic values. Disclosure of this information to the public may be in violation of both federal and state laws. To discourage the damage of vandalism and artifact looting, cultural resources locations should be kept confidential and report distribution restricted to those who need to know. Applicable U.S. laws include, but are not be limited to, Section 304 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 USC 470w-3) and California state laws that apply include, but are not be limited to, Government Code Sections 6250 et seq. and 6254 et seq. Accordingly, this report is not included in this copy of the Draft License Surrender Application.
