## **Kilarc-Cow Creek Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 606**

**June 13-14, 2007 SITE VISIT**

Dear Kilarc-Cow Creek Project Decommissioning Stakeholders:

As discussed at the Kilarc-Cow Creek Project Decommissioning Meetings held on May 15 and 16, 2007, PG&E has scheduled a two-day site visit for meeting participants and interested members of the public (stakeholders) to visit the Kilarc-Cow Creek Project facilities on June 13 and 14, 2007. While PG&E is not required to conduct the site visit, it is anticipated that the visit will facilitate future discussions regarding the license surrender application and decommissioning plan for the Project.

The purpose of this letter is to request that stakeholders RSVP for the site visit by **June 4, 2007**, in order for PG&E to make adequate preparations for the visit. **PG&E will not be able to accommodate stakeholders that fail to RSVP by June 4, 2007.** Please contact Brian Frantz (BFrantz@entrix.com or 925-988-1217) to reserve a place on the tour. You may reserve a place for either one or both days. PG&E will provide those that timely RSVP with logistical information regarding the site visit, including car pooling information, once final numbers for the visit are established.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT PORTIONS OF THE PROJECT ARE IN REMOTE AREAS. THE SITE TOUR WILL INVOLVE SITTING FOR EXTENDED PERIODS IN VEHICLES TRAVERSING ROUGH TERRAIN. HIKING OVER ROUGH TERRAIN WILL BE NECESSARY TO SEE SOME OF THE PROJECT SITES. POISON OAK MAY BE ENCOUNTERED.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT PARTICIPANTS BRING LOTS OF WATER, A SACK LUNCH, APPROPRIATE APPAREL, SUNSCREEN, AND MOSQUITO REPELLANT. THERE WILL BE LIMITED RESTROOM FACILITIES ON THE SITE VISIT. SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED WHILE ON PROJECT LANDS.
