<b>Bailey Cove campground</b>	ADA Parking, Path of Travel, Restrooms, Campsites, Water Faucet, Fire Ring, Picnic Table
<b>Bailey Cove day use area</b>	ADA Parking, Path of Travel, Restrooms, Campsites, Boat Ramp, Scenic View
<b>Centimudi boat ramp</b>	ADA Parking, Path of Travel, Restrooms, Water Faucet, Boat Loading Platform, Boat Ramp, Scenic View
<b>Jones Valley boat ramp</b>	ADA Parking, Boat Ramp, Scenic View
<b>Lower Jones Valley campground</b>	ADA Parking, Path of Travel, Restrooms, Campsites, Water Faucet, Fire Ring, Picnic Table, Scenic View

<b>Cave Campground</b> Hat Creek Ranger District, Highway 44, at Old Station, CA	Year Round	Accessible vault toilet, campsite, and fishing platform.
<b>Gurnsey Creek Campground</b> Almanor Ranger District, 13 miles west of Chester, CA on Highway 36/89	May to October	Vault toilets, with pathways adjacent to accessible single and group camping areas. Close to Lassen Volcanic National Park.
<b>Hat Creek Campground</b> Hat Creek Ranger District, Highway 44/89, one mile south of Old Station, CA	May to October	Accessible fishing platform and campsites.
<b>Hat Creek Rim Overlook</b> Hat Creek Ranger District, Highway 44, three miles north of Old Station, CA	April to December	Scenic and interpretive opportunity, RV parking, picnic area, fully accessible. Views of Lassen Peak and Mt Shasta.
<b>McCarthy Point Lookout Rental</b> Almanor Ranger District, north of Highway 32	May to October	Accessible fire lookout for rent. Two room cabin with kitchen and bedroom. Paved trail from parking to lookout.

<b>Panoramic Vista Point</b> Hat Creek Ranger District, Highway 44/90, five miles south of Old Station, CA	Year Round	Scenic interpretive opportunity, views of Lassen Peak. Deer Hollow paved trail winds through a tree plantation. Picnic area and vault toilet.
<b>Old Station Day Use</b> Hat Creek Ranger District, Highway 44/89, one-half mile south of Old Station, CA	Year Round	Accessible fishing platform and vault toilet.
<b>Old Station Visitor Information Center</b> Hat Creek Ranger District, corner of Highway 44 and 89 at Old Station, CA	April to December	Accessible interactive exhibits, maps, books, information and picnic area.
